

English

- Phonics: Learning new sounds and applying these to reading. Daily reading of phonics books. Building fluency and understanding
- Texts: Cyril and Pat, Three Billy Goats Gruff, The Troll, captions & dictionaries
- Reading: learning new vocabulary linked to our topic, reading Wishing Tales, exploring sentence structure in stories, understanding alphabetical order, dictionary definitions and reading captions.
- Writing: Writing dictionary definitions, a narrative story using a range of sentence types, including compound sentences.
- Handwriting: Revise letter shape and orientation.

Maths

- Number: Counting and ordering numbers, counting forwards and backwards, partitioning numbers, understanding and using tens and ones to make and compare numbers, using a number line, reading and writing number names.
- Naming and sorting 2D and 3D shapes, counting sides, edges, vertices and faces of shapes, making patterns with shapes.



Science

- Explaining the seasonal changes that occur from Summer to Autumn.
- Investigating daylight hours and how the length of the day changes at this time of year.



Art

- Exploring the world around us and finding objects to print with.
- Building up images by creating multiples.
- Using line, shape, colour and texture to explore pattern, sequence and symmetry.

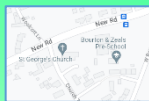


Parent Overview - Squirrels Autumn 1 – 2023 All Around Us

- Understanding the different bodies of water and which are local to Bourton.



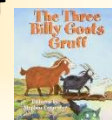
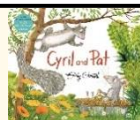
