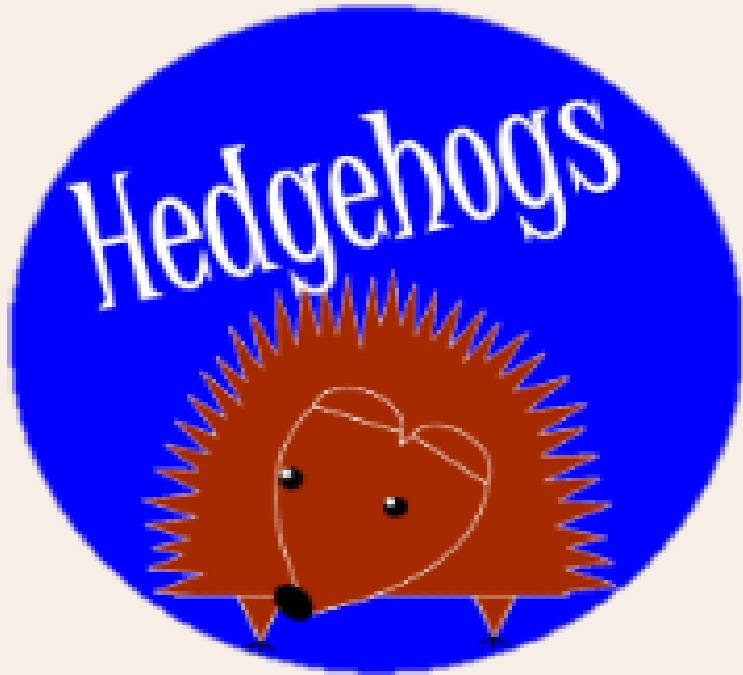

# Parent Overviews:

Hedgehogs and Squirrels complete a topic every half term. We are currently on a three-year rolling programme meaning the children do not repeat any topic before progressing to KS2.

## Topic = All Around Us

**English:**

- Continuing to use our phonics sounds from set 1, 2 and 3.
- Rereading our writing to check it makes sense.
- Leaving spaces between words.
- Correctly using capital letters and full stops.
- Composing sentences orally before writing them.
- Retelling and writing a tale of fear, houses and homes poetry and fact-files about city and village houses.
- Reading a range of fiction, poetry and non-fiction books.
- Handwriting: forming letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the correct place.

**Key Texts:**  
Town Mouse, Country Mouse  
We're Moving House  
A Walk in London  
Iggy Peck Architect

**Maths:**

- Addition and Subtraction (continued): Finding the difference and number problems.
- Place value within 50: Counting and ordering numbers from 20 to 50 and partitioning.
- Length and height: Comparing lengths and heights, measuring in centimetres and metres.
- Mass: Comparing and measuring mass.

**Music:**  
BBC Ten Pieces: No Place Like Home by Kerry Andrew

**Science:**

- Observing and describing how day length varies in the context of spring to summer.
- Observing changes across the four seasons by identifying signs of spring.
- Observe and describing weather associated with the seasons by observing and recording the weather in spring.
- Investigating rainfall by using rain gauges.
- Working scientifically by asking simple questions, using simple equipment to perform simple tests, gathering and recording data to help in answering questions.

**Computing:**

- Following instructions and arranging code blocks to create a set of instructions.
- Learning about object, action and event code blocks.
- Creating a simple program using code blocks and debugging when necessary.

**PE:**  
Gym Fit Circuits

- Developing balance coordination and agility.
- Learn a range of gymnastic balances and movements.

**Art and DT**

- Exploring different shapes of houses.
- Learning different joining techniques for cardboard, including making hinges.
- Designing a simple structure matching a brief for a specific type of house and person.

**RE:**  
Understanding Christianity  
Key Question: What do Christians believe God is like?

**Geography:**

- Using maps to identify the four countries in the UK and their capital cities.
- Learning about compass directions and using them to direct each other.
- Identifying the differences between cities, towns and villages using geographical vocabulary.
- Comparing the city of London with the village of Bourton.

**PSHE - Rights and Responsibilities**

- Learning about how to care for our world and look after our environment.
- Learning how to look after money, save money and keep money safe.

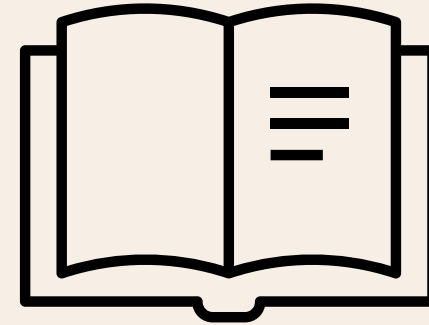
