- Phonics and spelling: Revising all sounds learnt, reading words and stories containing these sounds. Sorting spelling according to spelling sounds and learning spelling rules.
- Key Texts: Monstersaurus, Look Closer at Sea Creatures Bag of Happiness poem, Where the Wild Things Are,
- Curious Quests - meeting the Faithful Friends with challenges in grammar including using the conjunction because, suffixes, past and present tense.
- Handwriting: consolidating letter size & consistency and joining (Y2).

Maths



- Addition and Subtraction(cont.): Y1 - Subtracting ones using number bonds, counting back & finding the difference. Y2 - Revise adding two 2-digit numbers, then subtracting two 2-digit numbers. answering mixed + & - questions & missing number problems
- Multiplication and Division: counting in 2s, 5s and 10s (3s for Y2), equal grouping, arrays and the multiplication sentence. (Place Value to 50 for Y1s as well)
- Time: Telling the time to 5 minutes, writing the time, finding and comparing durations of time.
- Shape: Making patterns with 2d and 3d shapes, counting faces, edges and vertices, measuring length and height.

History and Geography

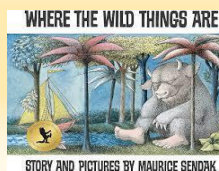
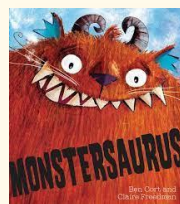
- Learning about the history of communication and who were the significant individuals involved in this.
